MAMIC SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Eligibility Guidelines:

- The scholarships will be presented to graduating high school seniors living in Missouri.
- Applicants **MUST** be a resident of Missouri
- Applications must be submitted to MAMIC through a MAMIC member company. Each company is limited to five (5) applications.
- Applicants must be attending a Missouri high school.
- Applicants must be planning to attend a Missouri college, university, community college or vocational school.
- The applicant must have successful admission to their designated school.
- All applications must be received in a MAMIC Member company office by Friday, March 1.

Selection Guidelines:

- Local MAMIC member companies will distribute as many applications to high schools in their area as they like. Along with the application comes a very firm deadline.
- The member company office will be notified if they have submitted an application that was chosen as the recipient
- Recipients will be chosen from eight (8) geographic areas within the state by Scholarship committees from different areas of the state.

Distribution guidelines:

- There will be eight (8) one-time \$1,000.00 scholarships granted.
- The scholarship award will be paid jointly to the educational institution and the recipient and will be paid prior to the beginning of the fall semester.

Please note that an additional \$1,000.00 one-time scholarship will be awarded to a student already attending a Missouri college or university. This scholarship winner will be selected by the board of directors. Applications are accepted as individuals are nominated and submitted by MAMIC member companies. Related information such as record of grades, work history, any professional involvement with insurance.
